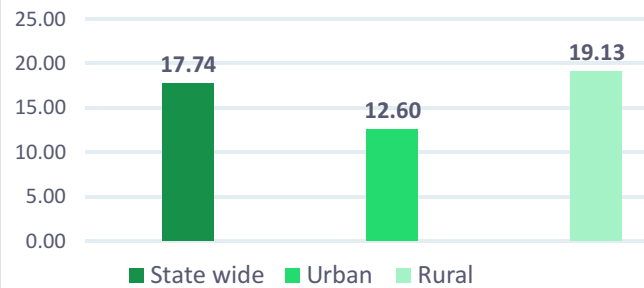
The Consumer Price Index – December 2021

The CPI year on year Inflation rate for Kaduna State stands at 17.74% in December, 2021. This was 0.20% lower than the rate of 17.94% recorded in November, 2021.

The CPI month on month basis in Kaduna State shows that the State Index stands at 244.16% in December, 2021. The urban index recorded 236.23% while rural index recorded 250.01% in December, 2021.

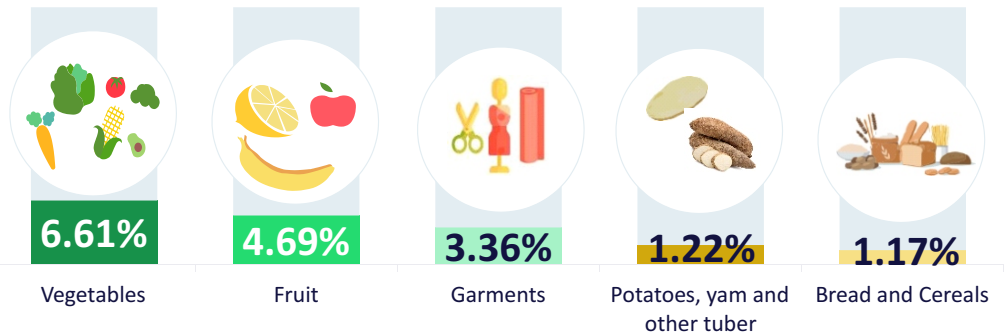
The State CPI month on month inflation rate was 16.77% in December, 2021.

KADUNA STATE DECEMBER 2021 CPI YEAR ON YEAR INFLATION TREND

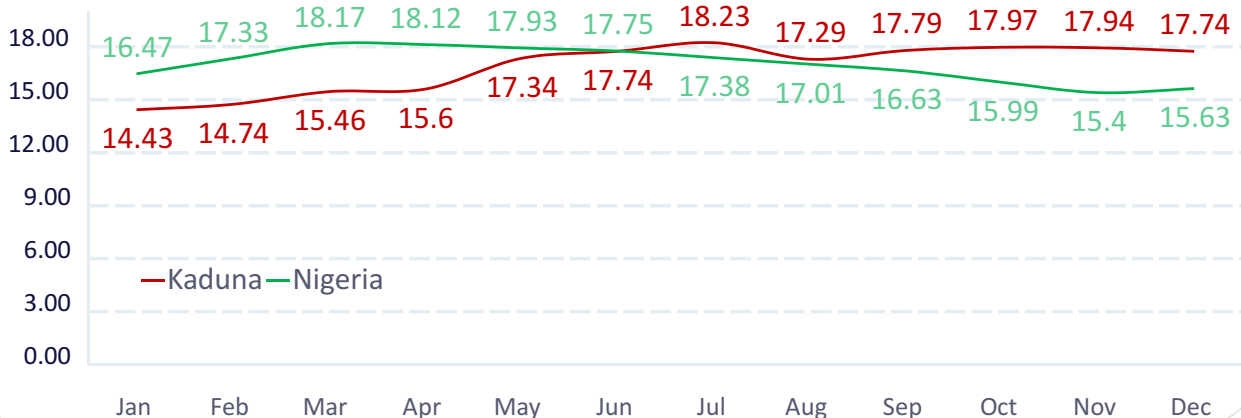

December CPI Index stands

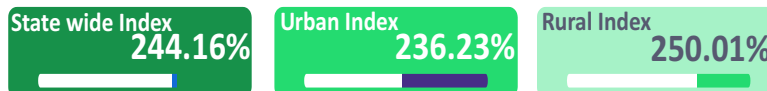
This value was up by, 0.25% from 16.52% recorded in November, 2021.

The urban inflation rate was 15.42% in December, 2021, increased by 0.25% from 14.85% recorded in November, 2021. The Rural Inflation Rate was 18.19% in December 2021, increased by 0.31% from 17.88% recorded in November, 2021.

The Top Five Absolute contribution that influenced the increase of the Month-on-Month December CPI Inflation Rate included: Vegetable 6.61%, Fruits 4.69%, Garments 3.36%, Potatoes, yam and other tuber 1.22% and Bread & Cereals 1.17%.

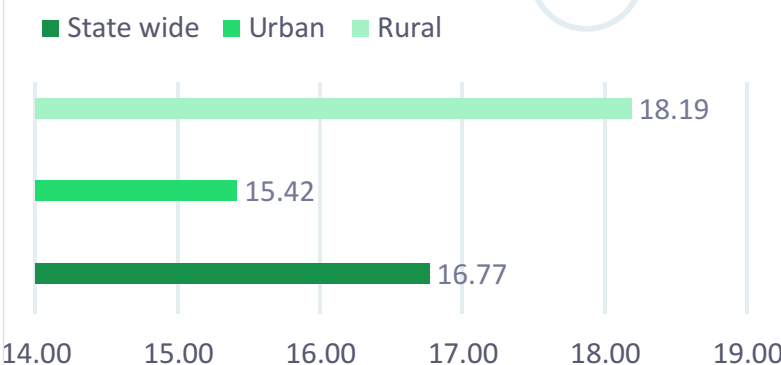
The Top Five Absolute contribution that influenced the decrease of the Month-on-Month November CPI inflation rate included major household appliances (7.44%), potatoes, yam and other tuber (6.19%), bread and cereals (4.73%), books and stationeries (4.32%), and garments (3.11%).

The highest contribution to the increase of December 2021 Month on Month Inflation rate was recorded in Vegetables 6.61%.

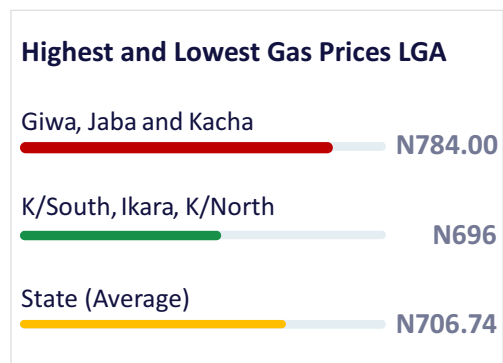
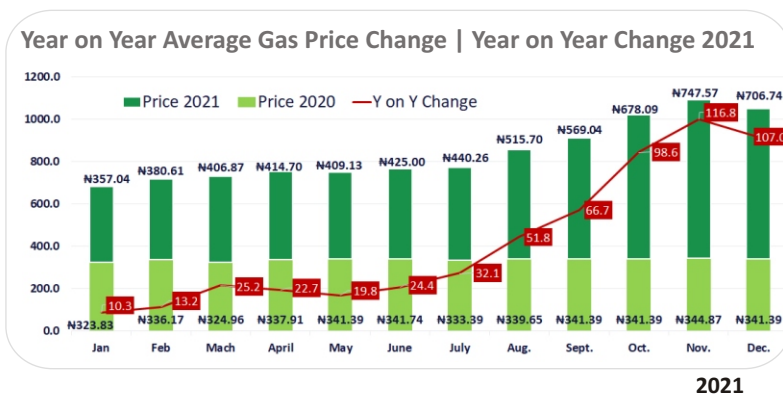
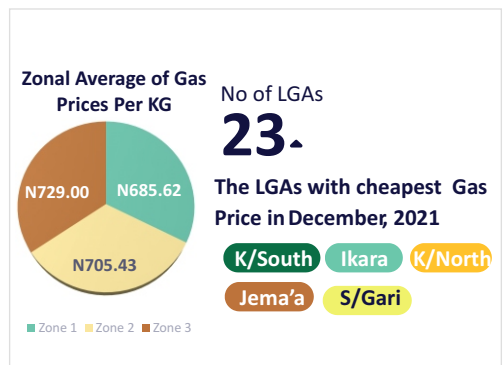
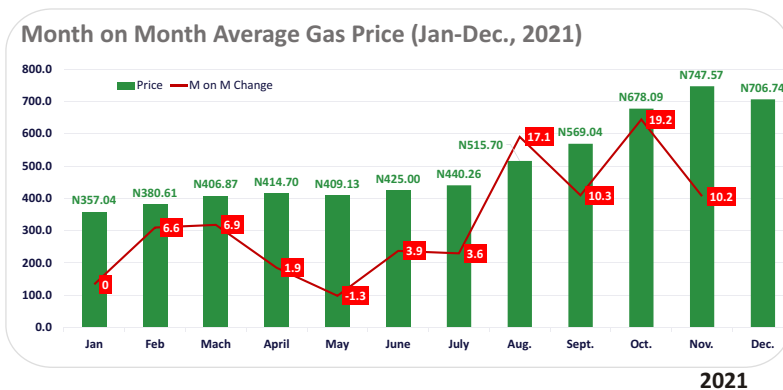
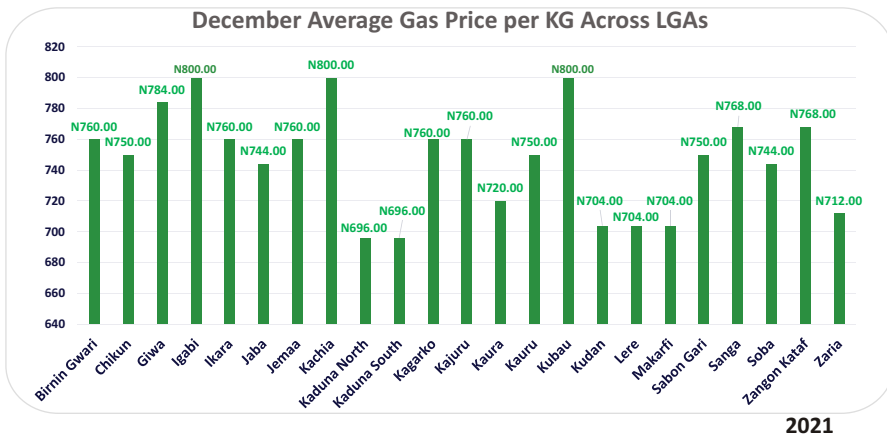
Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Cooking Gas) Price Watch

The Kaduna State Liquefied Petroleum Gas Average Price Watch is targeted at providing a Monthly average change of Liquefied Petroleum Gas Average Price (Per KG) consumed by people for day-to-day living as well as showing the Year-on-Year average changes in the State.

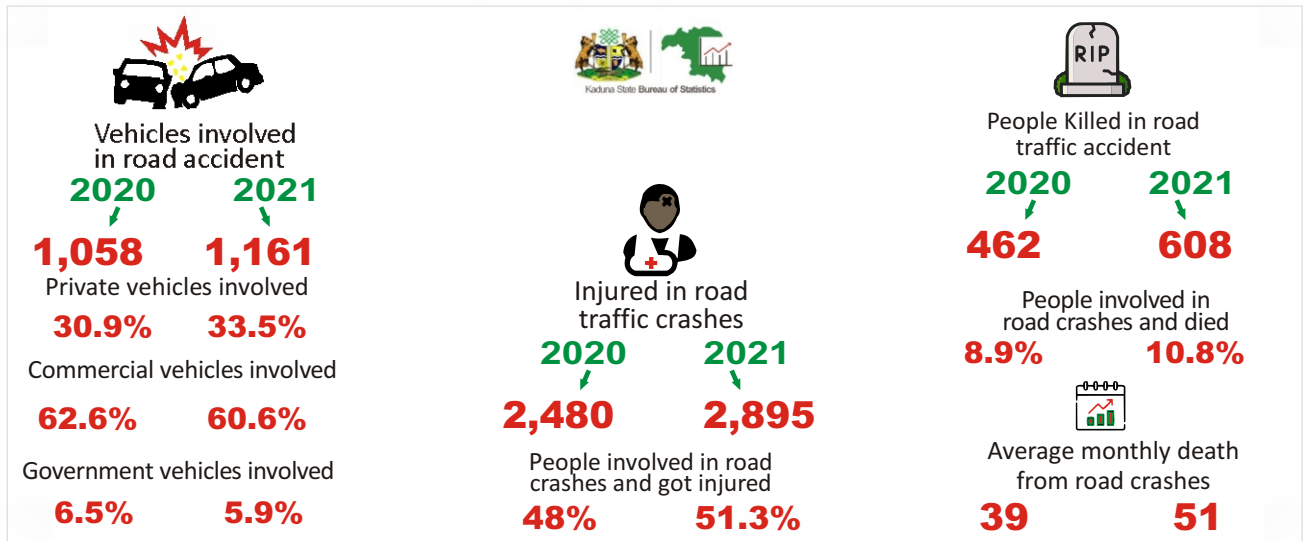
The average price paid by consumers for Liquefied Petroleum Gas Average Price (Per KG) decreased by 5.46% Month-on-Month, from N747.57 in November 2021 to N706.74 in December 2021. This increased by 107.02% year-on-year from N341.39 in

November, 2020 to N706.74 in December, 2021.

The Local Government Areas with the highest Monthly average price of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Per KG) in December, 2021 were: Giwa (N784.00), Jaba, Kachia and Zangon Kataf with (N768.00) each. The Local Government Areas with the lowest Monthly average price of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Per KG) in December, 2021 were: Kaduna South (N624.00), Ikara (N624.96) and Kaduna North (N640.00).
