



























PROPORTION OF POPULATION WITH ACCESS TO ELECTRICITY




PROPORTION OF POPULATION WITH PRIMARY RELIANCE ON CLEAN FUELS AND TECHNOLOGY




ANNUAL GROWTH RATE OF REAL GDP PER CAPITA








PROPORTION OF THE RURAL POPULATION WHO LIVE WITHIN 2 KM OF AN ALL-SEASON ROAD




MANUFACTURING VALUE ADDED AS A PROPORTION OF GDP AND PER CAPITA










PROPORTION OF DOMESTIC BUDGET FUNDED BY DOMESTIC TAXES
